About Juanjo Corbalán

He currently has his personal project, “Juanjo Corbalán Cuarteto”. Which gathers and rescues sounds of Paraguayan popular music, combining various elements of the traditional rhythms of Paraguayan and Latin American instrumental music and jazz influences, incorporating the folk instrument of Paraguay, such as the harp, within a freer musical context.

In 2019 the quartet has toured Europe, in various cities in Spain and Portugal, in 2020 they toured Uruguay. In 2022 the quartet has once again toured Europe, performing on stages in Belgium, Portugal, Switzerland, Germany and the Netherlands, the latter winning the first prize as a finalist in the “Dutch Harp Festival” contest held in the city. of Utrecht, an event that brought together harpists from all over the world. They have recently made their last concerts on their third visit to Europe, visiting stages in Spain, Portugal, Germany, Ecuador and Colombia.
