New Program for the Expansion of the National Electric System

The Electric Reform in Mexico seeks to transform and improve the electric power sector in the country to have a more efficient and modern system for the generation, transmission and distribution of electricity.

On June 30th, 2015 the Ministry of Energy ("SENER") issued the Program for the Expansion of the National Electric System ("PRODESEN"). The document comprises the elements required to modernize, develop and expand the National Electric System ("SEN"), the National Transmission Network ("RNT"), as well as the General Distribution Networks ("RGD"). Likewise, it defines which infrastructure projects must be developed to satisfy the electric energy demand in the country.
